

RHIP MINI-GRANT PROJECT SUMMARIES

Caldera High School BRYT Path at Caldera (“PAC”) Program

Organization: Bend La Pine School District

Summary of Results

- 46 students were served by the PAC team during the 22-23 school year.
 - This represents more than a 50% increase over the previous year.
- Continued to offer case management and academic/social emotional support.
- Funds purchased a rocking chair, bean bag and a hammock.
- Also purchased were additional items like plants which ended up being part of a neat project (see the story below).
- Students enrolled in the BRYT PAC program increased their classroom attendance by 25%, as measured by BRYT data and student attendance data.

Story

The additional investment for the 2022-23 school year significantly increased the capacity from the prior year, thus providing assistance to students helping them gain skills necessary for maintaining attendance and passing classes needed for graduation. One project that really captivated the students this past year was that we took some of our plants from inside and moved them (and our love of gardening) outside and planted and cared for new plants, brightening up one wing of the school.
