- Served 15 BRYT students for the 22-23 school year at Ensworth Elementary.
- Funding was used to create a calm, quiet space where students can chill and regulate.
- Trillium provided a part-time on site counselor who serves 13 families with the balance served by Care Solace.
- The Student Success Team organized a staff book club and read, “Relationships, Responsibility, and Regulation Trauma”
