

RHIP MINI-GRANT PROJECT SUMMARIES

Critical Home Repairs - Southern Deschutes County

Organization: Habitat for Humanity La Pine Sunriver

Summary of Results

- Funding used for critical home repairs to decrease severely mortgage burdened households in southern Deschutes and Northern Klamath County.
- Repairs supported accessibility, hygiene, and home safety (stability bars, ramps, electrical, plumbing) for households that otherwise would not be able to afford these repairs.
- Critical home repairs reduce housing insecurity, support aging in place, and sustain safe housing for people with disabilities.
- Habitat's 2021 program helped 45 households: 67% earning less than \$25,000 per year; 80% age 60 or older; 42% veterans; and 37% with disabilities. 100% of Habitat clients are low income, with many families below 30% AMI.
