

RHIP MINI-GRANT PROJECT SUMMARIES

Decreasing Rent and Mortgage Burden Through Social Determinant Supports

Summary of Results

- Helped over 5 households move from homelessness to housed with all the stability that a home provides.
- Provided approximately \$5,000,000 value in food and giving closet items to reduce rent and mortgage-burdened households.
- 295 Households received assistance with housing needs.
- Provided rent and mortgage assistance in the amount of \$54,576.55 to assist with housing stability.
- Impacted 468 Adults and 244 children who were either at risk of homelessness or were working to move from homelessness into housing.
- "The COHC grant made a huge impact on our ability to help our community with housing security."

Story

One of the families we helped with this grant consisted of a single Mom and her two small children, 4 and 6. When mom was offered a housing opportunity, the deposit was out of reach, We partnered with Jericho Road to cover the move in costs. When Mom was turning the key to her home, she called me sobbing, and said "Thank you Thank You Thank you!" I could hear the children in the background, picking out rooms and jumping up and down with joy.
