

# RHIP MINI-GRANT PROJECT SUMMARIES

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## Elementary After-School Literacy Improvement Program

**Organization:** Crook County School District

**Reviewed by:** Upstream Prevention: Promotion of Individual Well-Being

### Summary of Results

- Served about 54 elementary students throughout the program, 41 who stayed with the project for the entire year.
- Invited students to participate in an after school tutoring program, two days per week.
- Middle school students were invited to help the elementary students. Relationships were formed and the elementary students really looked up to their buddies.
- 60% of all Crooked River Elementary scored proficient or above on their Spring DIBELS Reading Assessment, a 20% increase from the Fall proficiency level (40%).

### Story

Crooked River Elementary is an AVID school. AVID stands for Advancement via Individual Determination. This is a nationwide program that centers around the promise that students can achieve anything they set their minds to and will leave high school being college and/or career ready. The students who came to work with our elementary students were part of the AVID program at the middle school. After school tutoring was an excellent bridge between our AVID programs, just another reason this project was so special.
