Summary of Results

- Assistance League supported more than 2500 students county-wide.
- This program frees household funds for other necessities, such as nutritious food, health care, or utilities.
- Students can attend school with basic clothing needs met, leading to better academic outcomes and long-term stability and success.
- ALB provided clothing bundles through Every Child Central Oregon 100+ children entering foster care or transitioning homes.
- 80% of respondents reported higher self-esteem and self-worth on caregiver/child surveys as a result of new school outfits purchased through Operation School Bell.
