Summary of Results:

- The \$5,000 COHC Mini-Grant afforded us the opportunity to expand our Socio-Emotional Learning Pod program through January 2021 to the week before school resumed meeting in person.
- Through this program, were able to provide intensive support to middle school students from the Bend-La Pine school district during distanced learning.
- TCC's Socio-Emotional Learning Pod provided intensive support to seven local middle school students in the Bend-La Pine Distant Learning Program.
- Designed to provide daily mentoring support, build emotional resilience, and foster social skills, the Learning Pod offered 33 hours of supervised online learning paired with socio-emotional learning activities throughout each week from November 2020-February 2021.
